Macari Baby, Inc. Recalls Movement & Positioning Video Monitor

**Cumberland, RI** – Macari Baby, Inc. announced an FCC recall of the Baby Delight Movement & Positioning Monitor due to non-compliance with FCC and ISED frequency ranges.

There are NO safety or performance issues associated with this recall.

Approximately 3100 monitors with item numbers BD04010 and BD04020 and date codes starting with 1611, 1612 and 1703 (located on the bottom of the camera) have sold in the US and approximately 410 in Canada. Most of these products were sold through Babies 'R' Us.

The Baby Delight Movement & Positioning Monitor was recalled when Bay Area Compliance Laboratories found that the Baby Delight Movement & Positioning Monitor exceeded FCC and ISED frequency range requirements when the handheld Video Monitor Unit is powered on, but the Camera is not in use. There are NO safety or performance issues associated with this recall.
